Scholarship Eligibility

The Louisiana Solid Waste association offers 3 scholarships in honor of Dr. Gordon P. Boutwell, Jr., William “Bill” Mollere and James “Buddy” Veuleman. These men were pioneers in the solid waste industry and an avid supporter of education.

These scholarships are available to all high school seniors planning to enter college during the fall semester the academic year. The scholarship will be awarded for full time study for one academic semester (Fall Semester). The panel will select three high school seniors. The scholarship amount is \$1000.00 per recipient and will be paid directly to the Louisiana university of choice. The funding shall be applied directly for tuition or any other associated fees for the recipient.

Recipient Selection Process:

Submitted applications will be reviewed by a panel designated by the LSWA Board of Directors. The panel will review the submitted applications, taking into account all aspects of the applicant's submittal, including field of study, scholastic records and awards, community service, and completion of the essay.

The panel will make a final decision of determination of applicants to be awarded the scholarship and will notify the LSWA Board no later than February 20th of the current year. The Board will formally notify the recipients no later than March 1st of the current year. The recipients will be formally introduced and receive the awards at the LSWA Environmental Conference in March of the current year.
